There is no age bracketing and contest is not for any constructed/sewn clothing--only the embellishments on them ! One entry form per item----use other forms for other items--a must !

Listed are categories and some suggestions for each category. write type of item like quilt, crochet doily, boa, etc.

Category I: Decorative, fancy-work, and household items

Div. 1 Decorative pillows, afghans, bedspreads(larger items), wall hangings _____

Div. 2: Decorative fancy work like doilies, runners, hot-pads, crocheted, woven, tatted etc. _____

Div. 3: Decorative crewel, cross-stitch, needlepoint, etc. _____

Div. 4 Embellished house linens like pillowcases, aprons, curtains, towels, etc. _____

Div. 5 Rugs, Quilt tops, completed Quilts-handmade or machine assembled or combo, etc. _____

Category II: Wearable

Div. 1 Woven, knitted, crocheted, but not a sewn wearable unless embellishment only for judging is on the coat, sweater, shawl, dress, hat(not crochet or knitted or woven hat), etc. _____

Div. 2 Small Woven, knitted, crocheted, etc. wearable, i.e. boas, mufflers, mittens, hats, socks _____

Div. 3 Decorative Beading, using a needle to apply beads as embellishments/decoration(not jewelry beading like bracelets, but on clothing, purses, etc.) _____
